



MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE FOR FASCIA/GUTTER


To help prolong the life of your guttering and ensure it is kept free of debris we recommend clearing and cleaning it every 6 months

- 1. The most effective, basic and necessary maintenance you should do is cleaning your spouting system thoroughly. We recommend you do this twice a year, once in spring and again in the autumn (more often if you have trees close to the house).
- Begin by securely placing your ladder so that you can reach the gutters easily. <u>Do not rest the ladder directly on the gutters, as you will damage them!</u> You may be interested in gutter attachments that allow you to raise your ladder higher without damaging your gutters.
- 3. Using rubber gloves, manually clean out any debris that you can reach in the spouting. It is a good idea to throw the debris into a bucket or garbage can directly so that you do not make a mess around your home.
- 4. Use a hose and spray down the spouting of any small debris. You should see the water flow out cleanly from the downpipe. Wash down the fascia with clean water and a soft-bristle brush or sponge.
- 5. If you are not comfortable doing it yourself get a professional in. It should be done on a regular basis to meet the terms of your warranty.
